# **NOTICE OF EMPLOYMENT**

#### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

The Tribal Attorney General shall be hired by Eastern Shoshone General Council. The (AG) will be responsible for legally protecting Tribal Assets, defending the Shoshone 1863 & 1868 Treaties, and defending the integrity of the Eastern Shoshone Tribe. The AG Tribal Lawyer shall be knowledgeable of Shoshone Culture, customs, resources, and traditions and/or a willingness to learn. Tribal Lawyer AG will live and operate on the Wind River Indian Reservation; and available for legal advice and counsel to the Eastern Shoshone Tribe, in all matters at issue before federal, state, and tribal courts.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. To meet/greet tribal members to know the community, Shoshone Business Council, Tribal Departments and Enterprises. AG Tribal Lawyer is to live at Fort Washakie.
- 2. Attend Shoshone General Council sessions to provide legal advise and counsel on a variety of legal matters; and Give Reports.
- 3.Review contract applications, and other legal documents, proposed legislation prior to signing and submission of documents; and
- 4. Collaborate with assistant legal Attorney on legal matters.

- **5.** Review Shoshone General Resolutions/Laws to make sure Resolutions/Laws are being followed. Policies and procedures, contracts and agreements on behalf of the Eastern Shoshone Tribe, it's depositions;
- 6.Research analyze tribal, federal, state legislation, regulations, and case law,
- 7. Provide written legal opinions an analyze developments in Indian Law.
- **8.** Attend tribal council sessions and other meetings. Represent tribe in statewide and national wide legal forums.
- **9.** Required knowledge, skills and abilities knowledge of Shoshone culture, customs, resources, and traditions, and/or a willingness to learn.
- **10.** Willingness to live and reside on the Wind River Indian Reservation.

# **QUALIFICATIONS:**

EDUCATION-CERTIFICATION & EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

Juris Doctorate from a law school accredited by the American Bar Association. And 4-10 years legal experience.

Knowledge of Indian Federal Law

Willingness to learn Shoshone History, and culture.

  - o Supporting documents: Driver's License, Tribal ID, High School Diploma/GED,

Degree or professional credentials and other supporting documents that verify required qualifications.

- Applicants who have a current application with supporting documents on file <u>must</u> submit a
  letter of interest. The letter should address how you meet each qualification. <u>Telephone calls</u>
  are not accepted in place of an employment application or letter of interest.
- Preference will be given to a qualified Eastern Shoshone tribal member, then other qualified federally recognized Indian tribal members and then other qualified candidates. Applicants must submit a copy of Tribal Enrollment card or CIB for Indian Preference.
- Veterans who meet the minimum qualifications and provide documentation of an honorable discharge (DD214) from any branch of military service are entitled to receive preference points during the interview process.
- Applicants being considered for employment will be required to pass an alcohol and drug test and a background check. Refusal to take the test or testing positive will render the applicant ineligible for employment with the Eastern Shoshone Tribe for 60 days.
